The College is seeking applications from committed and experienced teachers who are able to teach Music from Years 7 to 12, including the WACE ATAR and General music program.

Essential skills required:

- Ability to teach ATAR Music (Western Art)
- Ability to teach Certificate III (Music Industry Skills)
- Possess a CERT IV in Training & Assessment
- Ability to conduct bands and ensembles
- Can work collaboratively

The successful applicant will be required to be an active participant in teamwork and will be able to collaborate with a dedicated team of professionals that forms the teaching staff. In addition, teachers are required to actively participate in a cross-curricular approach in the Foundation Years (Years 7 to 9) and demonstrate their willingness to work with leaders and other subject teachers in a Professional Learning Community designed to maximize the opportunities for academic success for *all* the students they teach.

Teachers are expected to take an active interest in the pastoral welfare of their Pastoral group, supported by leadership, specialist subject teachers and specialist support staff.

For teachers in general, the ability to be involved in the extra-curricular life of the College will be an expectation. *As a member of the Performing Arts Learning Area there is an expectation your extra-curricular involvement will involve the coordination of an extra-curricular Music program.*

As with all teaching positions at Prendiville Catholic College, the ability to teach Religious Education would be a distinct advantage, as is the ability to teach in more than one subject area.

Preferred applicants must actively support the Catholic ethos of the College. All staff are expected to be involved in the full life of the College.

Please include a covering letter outlining your reasons for applying along with the completed Employment Application Form supplied below and Curriculum Vitae outlining any additional supporting information. Reference should be made to expertise and experience in extracurricular types of activities in the covering letter, as already stated.
