

ICT TEACHER: Ongoing from January 2018

The College is seeking an innovative teacher for the following ICT courses:

This is a part time role for 2018 (0.54FTE) but has capacity to grow and subject leadership opportunities are also a possibility. The College is embarking on innovative STEM initiatives and also an exciting development of its existing Technology centre.

This role could also be combined with ICT Learning Area Responsibility and/or a College eLEARNING brief as well.

Teachers should demonstrate the following qualities:

- Sound understanding of the current Western Australian curriculum and WACE courses.
- Use of a wide range of pedagogies that enhance student engagement and performance.
- Proficiency in the use of digital resources with a proven ability to learn new skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills in interactions with other staff, students and parents.
- Positivity in their willingness to build relationships with students.
- Familiarity with the SEQTA Suite and interactive whiteboards an advantage but not essential.

The successful applicant will be able to collaborate effectively with the dedicated team of professionals that forms our teaching staff.

Teachers are expected to take a keen interest in the pastoral welfare of their Pastoral Care Group (homeroom); supported by leadership, specialist subject teachers and specialist support staff. In addition, teachers are encouraged to actively participate in a cross-curricular approach and demonstrate a willingness to work with leaders and other subject teachers in a Professional Learning Community designed to maximize the opportunities for academic success for all of the students they teach.

As with all teaching positions at Prendiville Catholic College, the ability to teach Religious Education would be a distinct advantage, as is the ability to teach in more than one subject area. Preferred applicants must actively support the Catholic ethos of the College. All staff are expected to be involved in the full life of the College.
