The composite school fee covers the following items:

- Tuition Fee
- Subject Photocopying & Printing
- School Lock (Year 7)
- Student Insurance
- Camps/Retreats during the year
- Sports Fee
- Year Book

SUBJECT CONSUMABLES

Subjects that have a high consumable cost attract an additional fee for resources. This includes, but is not limited to, Home Economics, Art and TIDE. These costs are detailed on the College website.

CERTIFICATE COURSES

All Certificate courses incur an auspicating fee that is paid to an external provider.

SPORTS FEE

Included in the tuition fees, this covers all bus charges, admission fees to swimming, athletics and cross country carnivals.

BUILDING & TECHNOLOGY LEVY

The Building and Technology Levy has been set at \$610 per family and is **not** included in the above fee. Families with two or more children at Prendiville will only be charged \$610. The levy helps provide new buildings, establish or replace computing hardware, purchase additional capital equipment for student use and assists with payment of the substantial interest costs on our capital debt. This levy is below the maximum amount recommended by the Catholic Education Office.

SCHOOL BUS REPLACEMENT FUND

The School Bus Replacement Fund is \$45 per student and is **not** included in the above fee. This provides reserve funds for the replacement and maintenance of our school buses. A new bus was purchased in 2018.

PARENTS & FRIENDS (P&F) LEVY

The Parents and Friends Levy remains at \$75 per family and is **not** included in the above fee. Included in this fee is an amount of \$3.50/ student for registration with the Parents and Friends Federation of Western Australia.

MUSIC

Private instrumental music tuition and the related hire of instruments are charged on an individual basis. Information regarding tuition is available from the Music Department and is included in the orientation package. Payment for Music tuition is made direct to the tutor, **not** to the school.

HEALTH CARE CARD & PENSION CONCESSION CARD HOLDERS

In 2020 the College will discount fees for current holders of an eligible Health Care (HCC) or Pension Concession Card (PCC). The subsidy discounts the Tuition Fee to a limit of \$1,500. Camps, school locks, yearbook, subject consumables, Certificate fees, School Bus Replacement Fund, Building & Technology Levy and P&F Levy are additional.

Eligibility rules apply so parents/guardians are invited to present their original HCC/PCC card & if eligible, complete the application form available at the Finance Office from December 2019. *Please note: The HCC discount does not apply to HCC cards in the name of the student, DVA TPI & Gold, White or Orange PCC, Commonwealth & DVA Seniors HCC, Carer Allowance HCC, Mobility Allowance HCC, Ex-Carer Allowance (Child) HCC, Foster Child HCC or ABSTUDY students who access alternative government support.*

Application for the **Secondary Assistance Scheme** can also be made at the same time. Applications close on the 9 April 2020.

DISCOUNT FOR FAMILIES

Sibling discounts for children attending Prendiville Catholic College are as follows:

2 Children at Prendiville Catholic College	\$630 deducted from the annual account
3 Children at Prendiville Catholic College	\$2110 deducted from the annual account
4 Children at Prendiville Catholic College	\$7000 deducted from the annual account

Sibling discounts for eligible HCC/PCC holders will be applied as follows:

2 children at Prendiville Catholic College \$ 180 deducted from annual account
3 children at Prendiville Catholic College \$ 645 deducted from annual account
4 children at Prendiville Catholic College \$1700 deducted from annual account

PAYMENT OPTIONS: OPTION ADVICE FORM & DIRECT DEBIT DISCOUNTS

Payments can be made on a weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly, half yearly or annual basis. We welcome cash, cheque, BPAY, Direct Debit, EFTPOS, Visa and MasterCard. Credit card payments can also be made via telephone and Online Store. The options available for payment of fees are detailed on the Option Advice Form (OAF) which is emailed with the annual fee statement in February. Direct debit forms are also included. All families are required to complete and return the OAF by 14th February 2020.

A discount of \$50 will be credited to your fee account if the **Option Advice Form is returned to the Finance Office by 14th February 2020 AND the first fee payment is received by 20th February 2020.**

A further \$50 discount will be applied your fee account if **the Direct Debit Form (bank account) AND Option Advice Form are returned by 14th February 2020 AND the first direct debit is made by 20th February 2020.** *No discounts will be applied after this date.* These discounts are deducted from final fee instalments. *Please note: The direct debit discount does not apply to full payment discount recipients.*

FULL PAYMENT DISCOUNT

A discount will be applied to the annual fee for parents who pay the whole year account prior to 20th February 2020. This discount is \$150 for each child in your family attending Prendiville Catholic College. Holders of a HCC/PCC will be entitled to a full payment discount of \$50. *Please note: The direct debit discount does not apply to recipients of the full payment discount.*

FEE REMISSIONS

The School Board understands that some families may have a genuine case of financial hardship. Parents finding themselves in this situation are requested to contact the Bursar, Mr Raphael to discuss their situation.

REFUND POLICY

For students withdrawing from the school during the year, one term's notice in writing to the Principal is required to qualify for a refund. Verbal notification is not considered due notice. A pro rata refund or credit to the Family account will be applied accordingly. Students departing as at the end of Term 3, or during Term 4, are not eligible to receive a refund.

CAMP, RETREAT AND EXCURSION REFUNDS

In most cases these are prepaid in order to confirm the booking. In this respect, it may not be possible to offer full refunds on these items for non-attendance.

SCHOOL FEE COLLECTION POLICY

Parents please note this detailed policy in the College Board Fees Policy Statement.

INSURANCE

The College's Policy covers serious injuries at school in those circumstances where the school has legal liability. This includes excursions and camps. The school also provides a student personal accident insurance policy with limited benefits. This policy covers all students enrolled at Prendiville Catholic College for 24 hours/day, 365 days/year at school or home. A table of benefits is provided on a separate handout. Similar cover will again be provided for 2020.

If an ambulance is called to transport your child to hospital, the cost is paid by the parents. The approximate cost of an ambulance trip from Ocean Reef to Perth Children's Hospital is in excess of \$1000. We strongly recommend that all parents take out ambulance cover or check to see if their private health insurance covers such situations. Those on work experience are required to take out special insurance.

Voluntary workers - administration, "busy bees", etc are covered under the College's voluntary workers' policy.

STUDENTS LEAVING: Notification of students being withdrawn from the College must be forwarded to the Principal in writing as soon as this information is available. Please note the REFUND POLICY requiring one term's written notice to the Bursar when applying for fee refunds.**
