

## **FLEXed**

The FLEXed Pathway has been created for those students who are seeking a flexible learning environment to complete their secondary education at Prendiville Catholic College.

Designed for practical learners, students have the opportunity to engage with hands-on experiences which will provide them with an understanding of business and enterprise. Tailored to individual students, the FlexED pathway can lead directly to employment, further study or even a practical trade.

The programme is facilitated by a mentor teacher who will work closely with each student, personalising the learning experience and addressing each student's individual needs.

A unique aspect of the program is the challenge of managing a real-life business enterprise onsite in the form of the College Gallery space.

Students enter the program in Year 11, completing the course work over two years
